- Ensure safe tidy place of work
- Maximise use of own working time
- Communicate with site supervisor on any health and safety concerns
- Feedback to site management with near miss reporting

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Training

You will have training in:

Working Hours

Remuneration

Probationary Period

The company operates a standard 3 month probationary period, during which either party have the right to immediate termination of employment.

Holidays
